



AUDEVARD 2026 CLINICAL CASE COMPETITION RULES

Article 1 – Organization of the competition

The company Laboratoires Audevard SAS, with its registered office located at 37-39 rue de Neuilly, 92110 Clichy, France, is organizing a competition entitled "Audevard 2026 Clinical Case Competition" (hereinafter referred to as "the Competition"). This competition is open from March 15, 2026, to October 31, 2026, for a total duration of seven (7) months.

Article 2 – Purpose of the competition

The Competition aims to promote equine veterinary practice, facilitate the exchange of scientific knowledge, and highlight clinical cases illustrating the quality of horse care in Europe and the United Kingdom. Each participant must submit a case report with a maximum age of 5 years, presenting the management of a horse, limited to 2 pages maximum (excluding appendices) in English.

Article 3 – Participation conditions

The Competition is open to any veterinarian who holds a degree and is registered with the veterinary order or the equivalent competent authority in a European country or the United Kingdom. Participation is individual and free of charge. Case reports must be written in English and submitted by email to: trophy@audevard.com. Any incomplete, illegible, or late submission will be considered invalid.

Article 4 – Calendar

- Opening of submissions: March 15, 2026
- Closing of submissions: August 31, 2026
- Jury and public voting: September 1 to October 15, 2026
- Winner announcement: October 31, 2026

Article 5 – Selection process

At the end of the submission period, the received files will be evaluated according to the following criteria: relevance of the case, scientific rigor, originality, and clinical impact. The winner will be selected in two stages: (1) Jury vote: A panel composed of three independent European equine veterinarians and a representative from Laboratoires Audevard will select 5 finalists; (2) Public vote: Open to veterinarians and veterinary students via an online form (Google Form).

Article 6 – Prize

The winning veterinarian will receive a bank transfer of €2,000 (two thousand euros) net, paid by Laboratoires Audevard. The winner's name will be publicly announced through Audevard's communication channels, including the website, newsletter, social media, and press release.

Article 7 – Intellectual property and right of use

By participating in the Competition, each veterinarian grants Laboratoires Audevard a free, unlimited, and perpetual right to distribute, reproduce, publish, and adapt all or part of the submitted case report, on any communication medium (print, digital, video, website, social media, professional events) for scientific or promotional purposes targeted at veterinarians.

Article 8 – Personal data

By participating, veterinarians agree to receive email communications from Laboratoires Audevard. In accordance with European data protection regulations (GDPR), each participant has the right to access, rectify, object to, and delete their personal data by sending a request to: info@audevard.com.

Article 9 – Liability
